GRI + TNFD + SBTN: less chaos in reporting

Convergence between frameworks can reduce duplication, clarify metrics and improve the usefulness of information.

Point 1

The problem is no longer lack of reporting

Many organisations produce excessive ESG information with little coherence or executive usefulness. Dispersed metrics, overlapping frameworks and duplicate requests increase cost and fatigue.

Point 2

Convergence can reduce noise

GRI, TNFD and SBTN can improve interoperability, consistency and comparability when they are aligned instead of used in parallel without articulation.

Point 3

Coherent reporting requires data governance

Without ownership, reliable sources, consistent definitions and auditable evidence, any framework produces noise instead of trust.

Point 4

The real gain is executive

The objective is not to feed frameworks. It is to improve decisions, priorities and credibility with investors, management and stakeholders.

Point 5

What to do now

Map metrics, cross-reference frameworks, define ownership and build a roadmap based on risk, materiality, operational effort and relevance to investors or funders.

Conclusion

The next ESG cycle will not be about volume
